BRITTANY'S TOP 10 LIST FOR HAVING A GREAT VBS!

- 1. Make sure your child eats a BIG breakfast!
- 2. Check your child each morning to make sure they have their security armband on their wrist.
- 3. Bring any necessary medications to the VBS Nurse's Station.
- 4. Have your child get LOTS of sleep each night before VBS. VBS is going to be an exciting week!
- 5. Put sunblock on your child before you arrive at VBS.
- 6. Dress your child in "play" clothes so they can have lots of fun and not worry about getting messy.
- 7. Have your child wear play shoes so they can be ready to run!
- 8. Make sure your child leaves any unnecessary belongings (such as toys, electronics) at home. This is for the safety of all children.
- 9. Don't forget your child's MISSION MONEY so we can continue to support our missionaries.

VBS POLICIES AND PROCEDURES



CHECK-IN

- 1. Registration begins at 8:00 am
- 2. Register at table designated for the grade your child just completed
- 3. Your child receives his/her security armband
- 4. Your child will then proceed to grade crew line

CHECK-OUT

- 1. Line up outside at grade crew line
- 2. Show crew leader your child's security number for verification
- 3. You and your child are free to leave

Security Armband Policy

- Security Armband Policy: Each child will be given a security armband that should be worn all week. The band has a printed number on it along with a matching pull off tab for the parent. Parents are welcome to place this tab on their key ring or take a picture of the number with their phone. Parents are welcome to share a photo of the number with others (grandparents, friends, etc.,...) who would also be responsible for picking up the child.
- If the individual picking up the child from VBS does not have proper proof of matching numbers, photo ID is required from a guardian or alternate pick up listed on the participant's registration form.

- Armband Replacement: In the event the number has faded or is not visible, a new armband will be required.
 Armbands can be replaced at the Registration Table during check-in.
- If late arrival check-in or early pick up is needed please report to the VBS Office Room 107, located across from the Missions Café and a VBS Office Team Member will gladly assist you.
- All VBS volunteers will wear a blue SHBC Children's Ministry T-shirt for easy recognition.

Additional Security Policies

All children participating in VBS will remain in their assigned crews unless otherwise directed by the VBS Director or Crew Leader Director.

During arrival and dismissal parents may park in front of SHBC in the designated spaces beyond the registration area. Parking in rear of building is prohibited.

- A security background check will be required for all parents/ guardians who are interested in volunteering at the SHBC VBS.
- In an effort to keep all VBS participants safe, parents are asked to check in with the front office when entering the building.

Closing Ceremony

The closing ceremony for VBS occurs daily from 11:30 am to noon.

Parents are welcome to participate from our designated parent viewing section located in the rear of the worship center. This is a great time to experience a little of what the kids are doing at VBS.


Allergies

COME AND EXPERIENCE THE MANY OPTIONS FOR CHILDREN'S MINISTRIES AVAILABLE AT SHBC



As part of our KIDS Korner, Kidsville is a kingdom centered zone offered during weekend services and various other ministries of SHBC. It places your child in an age appropriate worship environment.

NURSERY•PRE-K•KINDERGARTEN

Worship KidStyle, another component of our KIDS Corner, will bring Bible stories and the day's truth to life in ways kids will understand. Focusing on who God is, what the church is, and ways kids can apply vital lessons to their lives, school-age children will learn how God's Word relates to thei lives today! Both Large Group and Small Group settings will be used.



1ST THRU 6TH GRADE



For all kids age 4 (by Sept. 30th) through 6th grade. There are 3 choirs: Preschool (age 4-K); 1st-3rd Grade; 4th-6th Grade. We learn about worship, praise, music and singing, utilizing scripture, hymns, and choruses. We present a fully-staged musical drama in the spring.

Our AWANA program provides a club atmosphere for children to learn and memorize bible verses, take part in a bible time lessons, as well as in AWANA games. Wed.-Sept. thru April.

Gear Up. Out to Jesus: Celebrate Recovery Youth is a biblically-based 12-step program dedicated to helping children and teens avoid and overcome hurts, habits, and hang-ups. We study the Beatitudes, employing large-group teaching and small-group sharing times.
